ORIENTATION INFORMATION SHEET

Where are we?

We're located at: 131/131 Harold Street, Highgate WA 6003. East Perth Train Station is less than a kilometer away and there are two bus stops (Stop ID: 12170 and 12138) just a couple hundred metres from college. If you drive, parking is freely available in the general vicinity – there are 3-hour spots, 2-hour spots and 1-hour spots! Just move your car during your break if you're gonna be around all day.

Once on campus, follow the signs to the reception area, get yourself registered and grab a seat.

What time is my orientation?

Day and Weekend Classes

- ELICOS: 8:45am on the Monday of your first week of classes
- VET: 9:15am on the Monday of your first week of classes

Evening Classes

- ELICOS: 2:45pm on the Monday of your first week of classes
- VET: 3:15pm on the Monday of your first week of classes

What should I bring?

- If your acceptance was conditional on providing us with some of your enrolment documents at a later date, make sure you bring all of the required documents with you on your first day or you may not be able to start classes.
- It takes a few days for banks to process some payments – so if you very recently sent your course fees payment, please bring along your payment receipt.
- You'll also need to fill up some forms, so make sure you have the following details handy: your residential address in Perth, your Australian contact number and the contact details of someone living in Australia who we can contact in the event of an emergency.

When do I get my Student Card?

We'll take your photo for your Student Card when you register yourself at the reception desk on your first day. Generally, your Student Card will be ready for collection within 2 days.

Additionally, students studying a full-time course of 6 weeks or more will qualify for Transperth concession. Fill up the Tertiary Smartrider Application Form and have it validated at reception.

Do I really need to go to the Student Orientation?

All students must complete the Student Orientation before commencing classes. You will only receive your Student Card, WiFi logon and Transperth concession after you complete your orientation. Orientation durations differ by course, but you should expect it to last anywhere between 2-3 hours. Your orientation day is also a great opportunity for you to meet your new classmates and make some friends.
